3. Is your character inspired by or related to a mythological figure?
4. What are your powers?
5. Do you have any weaknesses? Do your powers have limitations?
6. What are your distinctive features?
7. How are you costumed?
8. Do you have a partner or companion?
9. What is your origin myth? (Tell a brief story of how your character came to be a superhero.)
10. How did your hero's life history affect his or her psychological make up and outlook on life?
11. What does your character stand for?

Big Questions; Endless Reflections

1. When your character is resting or deep in thought, to what place does s/he retreat? A mountaintop overlooking the city? An abandoned warehouse? A famous monument?
2. What concerns does your character have in relation to his or her powers?
3. Does your character worry that his or her deeds are too intrusive on the lives of the humans he or she helps? Does your character feel the weight of responsibility for others?
4. What Big Questions tend to haunt your character?
5. Are there aspects of the Big Questions that make them too complex to answer simply?
6. Does trying to answer the Big Questions create more questions?
7. Does your character worry about the same issues that you do?
8. Does your character have a moral weakness?
