

## 2007 Claes Dohlman Award

The Claes Dohlman Award recognizes outstanding fellows training in the area of Cornea, Refractive Surgery and External Diseases. The Fellowship will be available to any fellow training in the aforementioned fields of ophthalmology who is currently in a cornea fellowship and will complete that fellowship in either July 2008 or July 2009.

The award will be granted to an individual or individuals through a highly competitive selection process. The selection committee is comprised of fellows who have trained at the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary and the Schepens Eye Research Institute under Professor Claes Dohlman, as well as past recipients of the Claes Dohlman Award, as well as distinguished individuals who have made contributions to the Society to help promote excellence in the training of cornea fellows. The number of awards each year will be based upon the amount of funding received. The award will be presented annually at the Claes Dohlman Dinner during the American Academy of Ophthalmology Meeting. Recipients will be asked to attend the dinner during the AAO meeting to accept the award.

The deadline for application materials is September 1, 2007. The recipient(s) will be announced before the AAO annual meeting.
