PROGRAM PURPOSE AND COURSE DESCRIPTION

The 32nd Annual Alumni meeting is a two-day program of lectures covering the major ophthalmic subspecialties. The meeting will be held on the University of Illinois at Chicago campus on Friday, June 20th and Saturday June 21st, 2008, in the UIC Student Center West (828 South Wolcott Street). Our Alumni Day meeting covers recent developments and new information in the major areas of general and subspecialty ophthalmology. The meeting attracts over 100 practicing ophthalmologists from the greater Chicago area, many of whom trained at the Illinois Eye and Ear Infirmary, as well as former residents and fellows from around the country.

Dr. Paul Sieving returns to the Illinois Eye and Ear Infirmary, where he completed his ophthalmology residency in 1982, to deliver the Kronfeld Memorial Lecture. Dr. Sieving has been director of the National Eye Institute since 2001 and is an accomplished research scientist. He has achieved an international reputation for studies of inherited and progressively blinding retinal degenerative diseases, such as retinitis pigmentosa. His laboratory study of pharmacological approaches to slowing degeneration in transgenic animal models led to the first human clinical therapy trial of ciliary neurotrophic factor (CNTF) for retinitis pigmentosa. He also has successfully treated X-linked retinoschisis in a mouse model using gene transfer, restoring retinal function. Dr. Sieving is the recipient of many honors and awards, most notably election to the National Academy of Sciences.
