Bicycle Transportation Planner

Position:

To manage planning contracts and activities of the Bicycle Federation of Wisconsin (Bike Fed) and to work with the Executive Director to solicit future contract planning work. This position reports to the Executive Director and would be responsible for managing planning support staff as needed. This position will be based in the Milwaukee or Madison, WI Bike Fed offices.

This is a salaried, full-time position.

Job duties:

- Manage and complete on-going planning contracts and activities within their current project time-lines and budgets.
- Perform planning tasks including public presentations, field assessments, and plan writing and formatting.
- Represent the BFW as a professional consulting firm specializing in bicycle transportation planning, GIS mapping, and related activities.
- Work with the Executive Director and Outreach coordinator to create a marketing plan for our planning consulting services.
- Produce project proposals and presentations in the effort to secure future planning contracts.
