

Eupatorium serotinum
LATE BONESET (Composite Family)

in the **Peacock Prairie** at the **James Woodworth Prairie Preserve**



Mostly tall, erect plants, branching at the top of the stem. The flowers are in small heads, together forming a broad, often flat cluster. Lower leaves broadly lance-shaped; uppermost leaves usually alternate. Flower heads longer than wide. 1-5' (30-152 cm) high.
