

**Geum canadense**  
WOOD AVENS (Rose Family)

in the **Peacock Prairie** at the **James Woodworth Prairie Preserve**



White flowers  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, the petals as long as or longer than the sepals. Stem smooth to slightly hairy. Stem leaves mostly of 3 toothed leaflets. 1-2½' (30-76 cm) high. At the Peacock/Woodworth Prairie, blooms about the 1<sup>st</sup> week of June through the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July.
