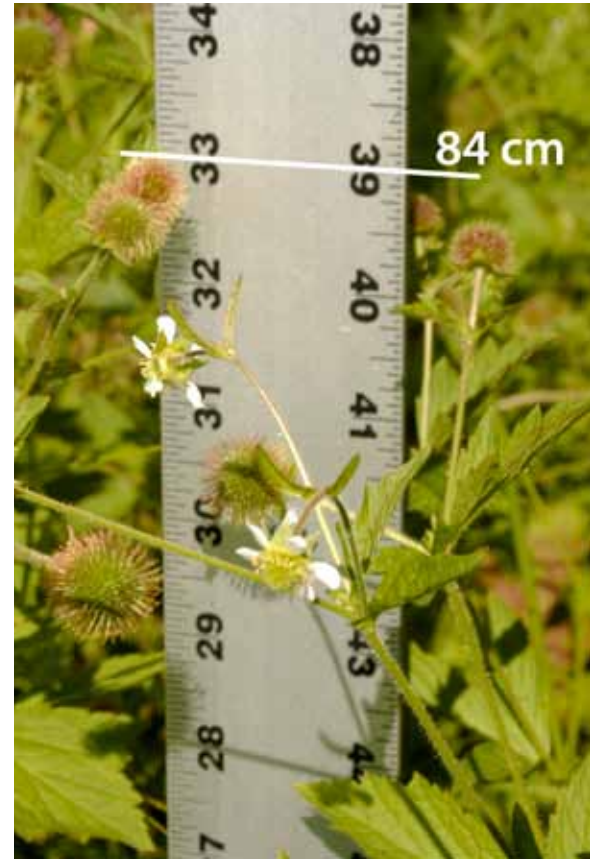


**Geum laciniatum trichocarpum**  
ROUGH AVENS (Rose Family)

in the **Peacock Prairie** at the **James Woodworth Prairie Preserve**



White flowers  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, petals much shorter than the sepals. Stem hairy. Stem leaves mostly of 3 toothed leaflets. Fruiting head a bristly ball,  $\frac{3}{4}$ " in diameter. 1-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' (30-76 cm) high. At the Peacock/Woodworth Prairie, blooms about the 1<sup>st</sup> week of June through the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July.
