

Krigia biflora

FALSE DANDELION CYNTHIA (Composite Family)

in the **Peacock Prairie** at the **James Woodworth Prairie Preserve**



Stem forked near the middle and bears a small, oblong, mostly entire, clasping leaf at the fork (stem occasionally forks more than once). Orange-yellow flowers in heads 1-1½" wide. Basal leaves lobed, toothed, or nearly entire. 8-24" (20-61 cm) high. At the Peacock/Woodworth Prairie, blooms about the 2nd week of May through the 1st week of July.
