

Lactuca canadensis
WILD LETTUCE (Composite Family)

in the **Peacock Prairie** at the **James Woodworth Prairie Preserve**



Pale-yellow or reddish-yellow flowers in small heads about 1/4" wide, the heads mostly longer than wide. Leaves very variable, ranging from deeply lobed on some plants to arrow-shaped, clasping and nearly entire on others. Stem smooth. 3-10' (91-305 cm) high. At the Peacock/Woodworth Prairie, blooms about the 4th week of July through the 4th week of August.
