

Lilium philadelphicum andinum
PRAIRIE LILY (Lily Family)

in the **Peacock Prairie** at the *James Woodworth Prairie Preserve*



Large (2-4" wide) and showy, orange-red or orange flowers, purple-spotted within, solitary or in terminal clusters. Flowers erect, the base of the petals and sepals narrowed to a stalk; leaves lance-shaped and mostly scattered. At the Peacock/Woodworth Prairie, blooms from about the 3rd week in June through the 2nd week of July.
