Take IL-29 S. Turn left onto JACKSON ST / US-51 / IL-16. Continue to follow IL-16. Turn right onto IL-128 / I490 E. Continue to follow IL-128. Turn left onto IL-33 / E 1900TH AVE. Continue to follow IL-33. Turn Slight right onto IL-33 E. Make a U-Turn at Avenue of Mid- America onto N Keller Dr. / IL-32 N / IL-33 W. End at 1202 N Keller Dr
