Its membership includes economists from colleges and universities, the business community and government throughout the State of Illinois. The Illinois Economics Association holds an annual meeting, usually in October, at which scholarly papers are presented and discussed. The annual meeting includes a plenary session lecture by a distinguished economist, sessions advancing the frontiers of research in economics, sessions on the methodology for teaching economics, and an outstanding graduate student paper session.
