Information About Transportation and Parking

STUDENT CENTER EAST

This is the building where the German High School Day will take place. The event is on the third floor of the building, you'll need to take two escalators up to the Illinois Rooms. There will be signs for High School Day once you enter the building.

BY CAR

The campus is located at the intersection of several major expressways (Dan Ryan, Kennedy and Eisenhower). There is a parking structure close to the Student Center (building 622 on the enclosed map). The entrance is on Taylor street. The cost is \$10.00 per vehicle, payable upon exiting the lot.

BY TRAIN

The Blue Line stops directly on campus at the UIC/Halsted stop. On the Forest Park and 54/Cermak trains, the stop is the first outside of the underground tunnels. On the O'Hare train, it's the stop after Racine.

BY BUS

Busses can be parked in Lot 6, 1135 S Halsted, just north of Roosevelt. If you plan to come by bus, you need to let Agnes know no later than Friday, February 13. Payment needs to be made upfront. The cost is \$20 per bus.
