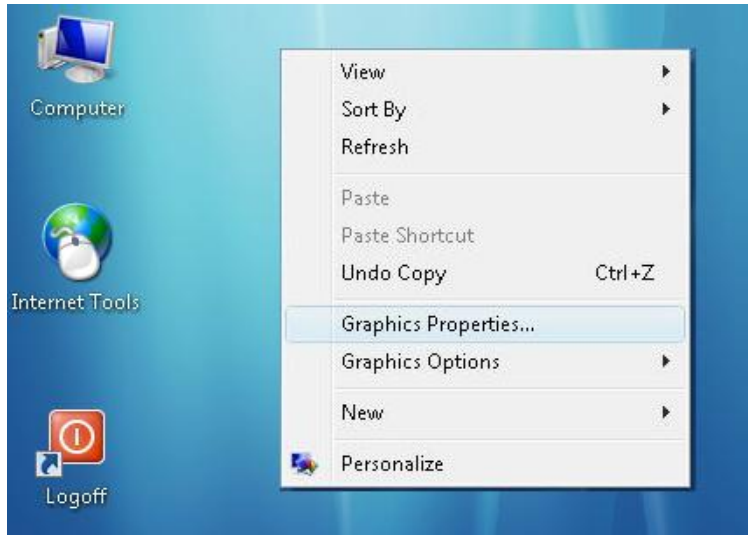


Adjust resolution of monitor on ACCC machines

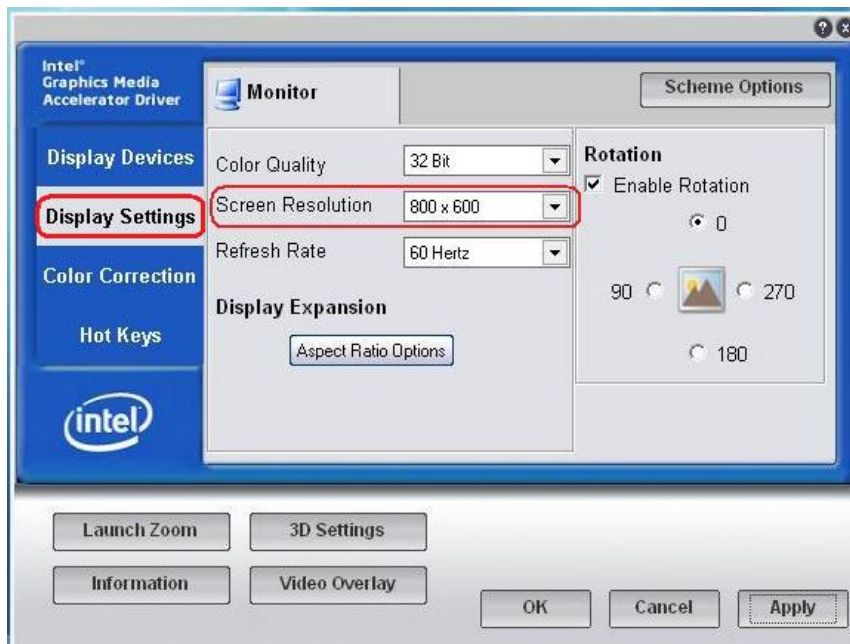
Is your display too limited? The icons are too big and too few lines show in documents?

1. Anywhere on a blank part of the desktop, right-click with the mouse. You will get this popup:



Select **Graphics Properties...**

2. You will get a popup window. In that window, select the second tab on the left side, **Display Settings**, and you will see this:

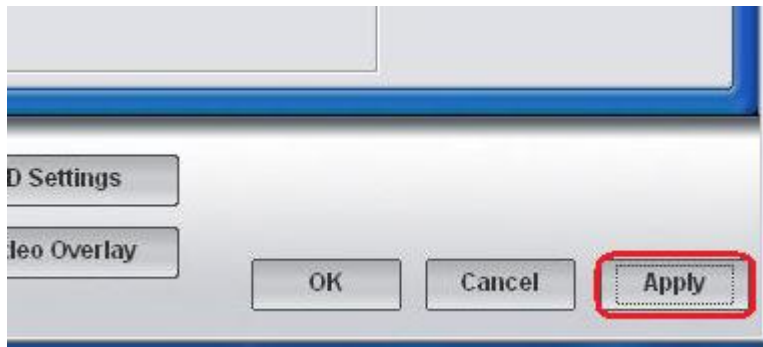


There are three drop-down boxes there. Use the middle one, **Screen Resolution**.

3. Change the value from “800x600” to **1024 x 768**.



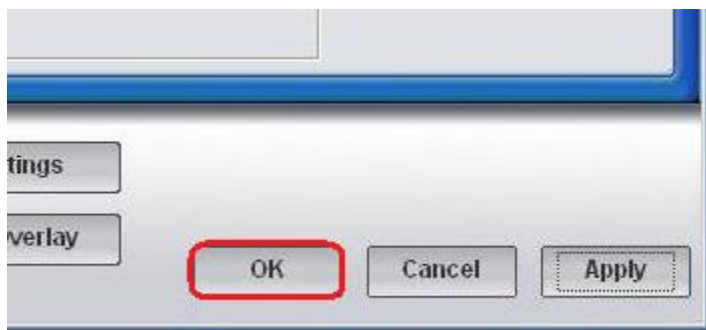
4. Use the **Apply** button on the bottom right to try out your change.



Do not be alarmed if the screen goes black or flickers for 2-4 seconds. After that, it should look fine.

If something has gone wrong and the screen is unreadable or black, simply wait 13 seconds and it should revert to its original display. DO NOT CLICK or hit “Enter” while waiting!

5. If the new setting is the improved resolution you want to keep, select the **OK** button, the leftmost button of the three on the bottom right:



If something has gone wrong and you prefer the original display, you can select **Cancel** instead.
