FREE ACCESS TO THE INTERNET FOR ALL CHICAGO PUBLIC LIBRARIES.

REQUIREMENTS:

A Chicago Public Library card.

If you live in Chicago and do not have a CPL card, apply at the circulation desk:

ADULTS

Show one ID with photo, name and Chicago address (Drivers License, Illinois State ID, etc..) or a combination of two pieces of identification with name and Chicago address.(no post box numbers will be accepted).

CHILDREN: (14 years and under)

Show one item with home address and complete an application with guardian's signature.

OPTIONS

EXPRESS INTERNET

- NO RESERVATION NEEDED
- FOR quick e-mail or Internet searching
- Limited to 15 minutes

OR

MAKE A RESERVATION

- USE THE designated PC Reservation Station
- Reservations may be made for the same day and we accept reservations for up to three days in advance (2 per day)
- Patrons are allowed a maximum of two, one hour sessions, per day.
- Be on Time- If you are more than ten minutes late, or do not show up at all, your reservation is cancelled

PRINTING POLICY

- The Chicago Public Library lets computer users print the first 10 pages, per day, free.
- Computer users will be charged 15 cents per page for each additional page after the first 10 free pages.
