

CHICAGO [ILLINOIS] WOMAN'S AID

The Young Ladies Aid Society, organized November, 1882, was incorporated by the state of Illinois in 1895 and renamed the Chicago's Woman's Aid. The founding members adopted the motto "She lightened the burden of life to others"--Romola, which guided them in establishing programs of civic, philanthropic, literary, educational, and social welfare nature.

To develop these programs more fully, the executive officers created the Civics and Philanthropy Department to give assistance to those seeking public housing, to safeguard public morality, to provide milk for school children, etc.; the Educational Department which furnished books for the library of the Maxwell Street Settlement, to assist in the maintenance of summer school programs and playgrounds, etc.; and the Art and Literature Department to encourage local artists to exhibit their paintings, to sponsor lectures and concerts for adults and children, etc. Besides these departments, standing and special committees are used to conduct business affairs and to supervise special projects.

The Chicago Woman's Aid corresponded with the following people: Emily Taft Douglas, Clarence Darrow, Rachele Yarros, Louise de Koven Bowen, Charlotte Carr, Anton J. Cermak, and Edward Joseph Kelly.

The papers of the Chicago Woman's Aid comprising 10 ft. are on file in the Department of Special Collections at the University of Illinois Library, Chicago Circle Campus. These papers were obtained through the Department of History and deposited in the Library on July 2, 1968 and November 8, 1968 with no known restrictions.

The alphabetical arrangement of the labeled folders was retained with the material within each folder arranged chronologically.

The papers consist of correspondence, reports, lists, photographs, clippings, speeches, notes, scripts, bulletins, calendars, pamphlets, programs, memoranda, statements, leaflets, and minutes pertaining to the origin and social service activities of the Chicago Woman's Aid, including material on anti-Semitism, birth control, the braille system, Chicago Board of Education, Heart Association and Urban League, child welfare, civilian defense, discrimination in education and employment, public housing, police districts, the Illinois League for Planned Parenthood, Illinois Parole and Prison Administration, juvenile delinquency, narcotics, naturalization of immigrants, Negroes in Chicago, recreational centers and playgrounds, sex offenses, and Jewish refugees.

Chicago Woman's Aid Society: Supplement I – (1892-1988), approx. 11 linear ft.

Scope and Content: The Chicago Woman's Aid Society: Supplement I consists of reports, correspondence, photographs, clippings, notes, administrative files, yearbooks, bulletins, plaques, award certificates, scrapbooks and other commemorative materials. Some items from Jewish philanthropic organizations such as the Jewish Welfare Board are also included.
