Composers of the text for the other links will be reminded to submit their drafts to the listserv for comment before the next meeting.

Campus Hot Spots

The draft page was reviewed. It was agreed

-to change the title to UIC Campus Links

-to change Campus Police to UIC Police Department

-to drop the link to Visiting UIC

With these changes, the page is ready to go live and should be added to the bottom of the Quick Links

In discussing the page, it was agreed that this page is for high use and hard to find UIC pages and that it should be a limited set of links.

Services Task Force - Charge #1

The report from the Task Force was reviewed. The team agreed to consider whether additional groupings should be included beyond the one recommended. Further discussion was deferred until the next meeting.

Link for E-Reserves

ERQ is awaiting more information from Hepburn before addressing this issue.

Privacy Statement for Web site

The consent and privacy issues surrounding the conversion of lib-sugg emails by staff to Ask A Librarian were reviewed. It was reported that Dorsch has requested this as an

agenda item for the Steering Committee. The majority in attendance were less concerned about the consent issue at this point in time. A recommendation to address the privacy aspect was made - to provide a link on the lib-sugg form to the Ask A Librarian privacy statement. Pifalo will relay this recommendation to Dorsch.

qUICsearch

Hurd proposed adding a Quick Link for qUICsearch based on statistics showing high usage. It was agreed that the statistics justified inclusion as a Quick Link. Pifalo will forward the information about the position in the Quick Links and the description to Sullivan.
