## Pilot Grant Program

### 2008 PILOT GRANT PROGRAM UPDATE

December 10, 2008

The Center for Clinical and Translational Science (CCTS) announced its 2008 Pilot Grant Program in June 2008. The program, supported by the Office of the Provost, the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research, and the Health Science Colleges, focuses on clinical and translational research – either involving human subjects, facilitating human subject investigations, establishing infrastructure related to human subject investigation, or concerning disease mechanisms with clear, near term implications for therapeutics or prevention.

The CCTS received 75 applications for funding, and these are currently in the review process. Funding decisions are expected to be made by late January, 2009.
