## **DATES FOR AWARDING DEGREES**

The College of Medicine students who are completing their M4 year should have an understanding of how their degree is awarded and the documents they will need after they graduate. Your degree is awarded by the University of Illinois at Chicago. The University only awards degrees on certain dates and are listed below.

<b>Degree Conferment</b>	<b>Conferment Date</b>	<b>To be considered and eligible for graduation, you must be passed all clinical requirements, passed USMLE Step 2 CK and Step 2 CS:</b>
Spring 2010	May 9, 2010	by June 19, 2010
Summer 2010	August 8, 2010	between June 20, 2010 and August 21, 2010
Fall 2010	December 12, 2010	between August 23, 2010 and December 25, 2010

If you are going to be a summer semester graduate and only have remaining clinical requirements, which will be completed before July 1, and your residency program requires a letter of verification, the Office of the Registrar will write a letter, including the College of Medicine seal, stating that you have completed graduation requirements but due to the University's calendar your degree will not be conferred until the end of the summer semester.
