

## Access to Academic Career Information for Enrolled Students

Exam Scores are now available on the web. The summaries are by year and are presented in SAS Report Format. You can “drill down” to existing score result distributions by linking from the initial report output.

This new URL is designed to eventually replace the individual paper score report summaries and score distribution graphs.

The report is protected by the University’s Bluestem system.

You may be prompted to accept security certificates from \*.comd.uic.edu. You will need to unblock popups from \*.comd.uic.edu. Additionally you may be prompted to accept certificates from SAS.Com(SAS Institute) which you should do.

The web graphics are Java based and if you do not have a SUN Java Runtime Engine (JRE) plugin installed on your browser you will be prompted to download and install it. The JRE plugin allows end-users to run Java applications in a browser. You should install the JRE Version 5.0 Update 15 on your computer and it is available at [http://java.sun.com/javase/downloads/index\\_jdk5.jsp](http://java.sun.com/javase/downloads/index_jdk5.jsp) Follow the prompts.

To access the Score Summary on your favorite browser use the following URL:

You will be prompted to authenticate to the University Bluestem system. After you enter your UIC NetID/Password on the Bluestem authentication page you will be requested to acknowledge a FERPA Agreement statement (legal stuff).

To learn more about FERPA, choose “I do not understand” which will take you to an information page for the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). This page displays the FERPA policy in detail, including Legislations, Regulations and Policy guidelines.

When you choose “I agree”, you affirm that you understand the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), and that you are authorized to access your Academic Career Information.

A greetings page with your name and current mailing address is displayed. If you need to you can update your mailing address in the University system (Banner) with the link for “UIC Web for Student” that is available for your convenience. UIC Web for Student is a comprehensive resource for current students that include Registration, Financial, Academic Summary and Personal information.

The menu page currently only allows you to submit a request for Basic Science Score and Grade Reporting. As more options become available they will be added to the menu.

To see a score distributions click on the underlined text links in your report. A Java graphic will be generated. The initial graph may take a few seconds depending on your PC’s start time for the Java Runtime (you will see a Java logo as it starts up)

You may log out of the application by using the logout button on the menu or the “Logout from BlueStem” link on the report pages.

You should always shut down (close) your browser when you are finished with a secure session that required a login. We recommend that you set your browsers to clean browser cache and cookies when you close it if you are working from a public access computer. However, we recommend that you do not use public access computers to log into secure sessions unless you can be sure that the computer has not been compromised.

Students may be able to access the wireless network on campus with their laptops by installing the Odyssey client for Windows XP or SecureW2 add on for Vista. The download and installation instructions can be located at:
