College Committee on Faculty Appointments, Promotions and Tenure
Annual Report 2009 - 2010

The College Committee on Faculty Appointments, Promotions, and Tenure (FAPT) reviews and makes recommendations on College criteria for academic ranks, on the form by which promotions come to the Dean, on individual appointments and promotions to the associate professor and professor ranks in the Academic (RT), Academic (CT), Research, and Clinical Discipline Tracks, and on the awarding of tenure. Committee activities for 2009-2010 were conducted at three full-day meetings and two teleconferenced meetings.

A total of 9 new appointments, 27 promotions, and 2 awarding of tenure recommendations were reviewed by the Committee. A breakdown of the Committee's recommendations is as follows:
