Who sits on this committee?

- 27 elected and appointed representatives of all UIC Colleges; diversity of departments
- Medical campuses represented
- All are Full Professors or equivalent senior rank

What is our charge?

- To answer the question “Why do you think the case merits promotion at UIC”?
- To provide a wider perspective in evaluating the scholarly contributions of candidates
- To advise the VC for Academic Affairs

What do we look for ?

- “Triple threats” Evidence of excellence in teaching, research, and service consistent with UIC’s expectations for promotion and tenure:

research

- Strong, externally funded program with significant contributions to literature. Editorial boards, Peer Review Groups, Invitations--true international reputation.
- What is your unique contribution?
- External reviewers important to evaluation
- Interdisciplinary work and innovative programs

Teaching

- Strong evaluations from both students and peers.
- Unique contributions to the educational mission of the department and UIC.
- Innovative development

Service

- Multiple levels at UIC
- Professional Societies, Editorial Boards, Review Groups.
- Community service (broadly defined)
