CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE – FALL 2009

Students admitted to the MS-MIS Guaranteed Professional Program Admissions (GPPA) for the Fall 2009 semester are required to:

- Enroll in UIC's Honors College and fulfill all requirements for continued membership in the Honors College including minimum grade point average.
- Complete business core courses as outlined by the College of Business Administration in addition to technical foundation courses including IDS 401, 405 and 410. Also achieve a minimum GPA of 3.0 for IDS 200, 270, and 355.
- Participate in career exploration seminars and complete a minimum of one business internship facilitated by the College of Business Administration Career Services Center.
- Active participation in the Information and Decision Sciences Organization (IDSO) to enhance leadership skills.
- Complete all requirements of the baccalaureate degree within five years of entrance to UIC.
- Submit the following application and admissions requirements by the appropriate deadline: application form, one page personal statement, GMAT or GRE score. Student must receive a GMAT or GRE score that is equal to or above the mean score of the prior year's matriculating class.

Upon satisfactory completion of all program requirements, including coursework and minimum grade point average, a seat in the UIC MS-MIS program will be held for up to three years following graduation in case the student chooses to gain full-time work experience prior to MS-MIS studies.
