**COLLEGE OF NURSING
CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE FALL 2007**

During the freshman and sophomore years of study at UIC College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the admitted GPPA student must:

1. Satisfy the prerequisite course requirements for admission to the upper-division nursing curriculum.
2. Enroll in the Honors College and fulfill all requirements for continued membership each term, including minimum grade point average.
3. Maintain a full-time (minimum 12 semester hours) course load during each semester.
4. Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.40 (A = 4.00).
5. Meet at least once annually with a committee of the following people: their Honors College Fellow (advisor) and a member of the Undergraduate Admissions and Standards Committee.
6. Participate in a volunteer activity related to his/her academic goals.
