

Application procedures and advice for UIC applicants for British scholarships

Please note the Rhodes, Marshall and Mitchell all require a university nomination. To apply to be nominated you should contact Beth Powers in the Office of Special Scholarship Programs well in advance of the Sept. 11 deadline and **be prepared to submit all requested materials to the office by Sept. 11.**

Gates Cambridge: The Gates Cambridge Scholarship does not require a university nomination but past successful applicants have worked closely with the office throughout the application process. To gain the best possible feedback, you must submit paper materials to the Office of Special Scholarship Programs by Sept. 11, 2009. A printout of the Cambridge application with Gates essays included and letters of reference should be received in the office by the end of the day on Sept. 11. This will require you to submit hard copies, rather than use the online system. It is best to discuss references with Beth Powers as you decide to apply. An interview by a campus scholarship committee will follow. It is advisable to contact the office well before the deadline to discuss your application.

Marshall: The Marshall Scholarship **requires a university nomination**. In order to apply for a nomination, you must submit materials to the campus committee by Sept. 11, 2009. Your Marshall personal statement, proposal and application form must be filled in online by Sept. 11. Letters of reference can be submitted online or sent in to the office by that date. It is best to discuss references with Beth Powers as you decide to apply. An interview by the campus selection committee will follow. It is advisable to contact the office well before the deadline to discuss your application.

Mitchell: The Mitchell Scholarship **requires a university nomination**. In order to apply for a nomination, you must submit paper materials to the Office of Special Scholarship Programs by Sept. 11, 2009. Your Mitchell essay, resume, application form and letters of reference should be received in the office by the end of the day on Sept. 11. This will require you to submit hard copies, rather than use the online system. It is best to discuss references with Beth Powers as you decide to apply. An interview by the campus selection committee will follow. It is advisable to contact the office well before the deadline to discuss your application.

Rhodes: The Rhodes Scholarship **requires a university nomination**. In order to apply for a nomination, you must submit paper materials to the Office of Special Scholarship Programs by Sept. 11, 2009. Your Rhodes essay, resume, application form and letters of reference should be received in the office by the end of the day on Sept. 11. This will require you to submit hard copies, rather than use the online system. It is best to discuss references with Beth Powers as you decide to apply. An interview by the campus selection committee will follow. It is advisable to contact the office well before the deadline to discuss your application.

The Fulbright Fellowship also offers the opportunity to apply for 10 months of study in the UK. Interested students should contact Beth Powers for more information on the Fulbright process.
