Summer Program in the Arts**

Brief description of summer program

***THINKING, DRAWING, MOVING, MAKING***

The School of Art & Design, the School of Architecture, and The Department of Performing Arts will jointly conduct an intensive 4-week immersion studio for new admitted students who will enter the college in Fall 2009. Space permitting, new admitted students in other UIC colleges will be accommodated.

“How to Apply”

Students may apply by either mailing or faxing the Summer Program in the Arts Application form (on the web site). **The deadline for application is Friday, June 12, 2009.**

Eligibility-targeted students (How are students selected to participate in the program?)

The workshop is free and open only to admitted Beginning Freshmen students who will enter the School of Art & Design, the School of Architecture or the Department of Performing Arts first year programs in Fall 2009. Students from other colleges will be admitted pending space availability on a first come, first served basis. A maximum of 40 students will be accepted for the program

How long does the program last? What is the start? What is the end date? (Please list days and time)

Thinking, Drawing, Moving, Making runs from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm on Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays beginning June 22, 2009. The last class will meet July 17. A reception/final exhibition of the student's work will take place the evening of July 17.

Briefly list goals of the program and student outcomes (benefits of participating in the program)

This workshop will introduce craft, drawing, model-making, photography, multi media technology, movement, performance, and critical skills. Scavenger hunts and walking tours will familiarize students with UIC and its local environment. Items gathered and photographed on the walking tours will be incorporated into subsequent visual, architectural and performance exercises. The course will culminate with a reception and exhibit of the students' work. This experience in the arts and architecture will serve as an introduction to the programs of Architecture, Art & Design, and the Department of Performing Arts. The specific course work and projects will enable students to gain an interdisciplinary overview of the professional and educational career opportunities in architecture and the arts.

In addition, students will have an introduction to UIC and college life. Students will be expected to participate in some off campus activities/field trips and may need to use public transportation. Past field trips have included the Chicago Architectural Foundation, Museum of Contemporary Art and the Redmoon Theatre Workshop.
