TRANSFER ADMISSION GUIDELINES

The UIC College of Business Administration reserves the right to adjust admissions criteria based on space availability. The following guidelines are the minimum requirements needed in order to be considered for admission into the College. Admission is competitive and selection for admission depends on space limitations and the overall applicant pool.

- Minimum cumulative grade point average 2.50 (A = 4.0) in 24 semester hours at the time of application and 36 semester hours at time of enrollment.
- Completion of English Composition I and II (or equivalent), Finite Mathematics and Calculus I (or Business Calculus) are recommended to be completed at time of enrollment.
- Completion of English Composition I (or equivalent) and Calculus I (or Business Calculus) are **highly recommended** at time of application and may be used as a determining factor for admission
