

## Transfer Requirements Guide for Nursing – Morton College

The College of Nursing upper division undergraduate program leads to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing. The curriculum reflects the need for a strong science-based program; development of decision-making skills; and, community-based clinical experiences.

### Transfer Admission Guidelines

The College of Nursing admits qualified transfer students from accredited institutions. Applicants are required to have a minimum 2.75 (A=4.0) cumulative transfer GPA and a 2.50 natural science GPA for consideration. Admission is competitive. To be considered for the College of Nursing, applicants must complete all of the following prerequisite coursework prior to Fall term enrollment with grades of C or better in all courses. **Natural Sciences must have been completed within the last seven years. Minimum of three of the five natural science prerequisites, excluding Nutrition, must be completed by the final application deadline of January 15<sup>th</sup>.** Nursing offers one on one counseling by appointment at 845 S. Damen. Appointments may be made by calling the College of Nursing at 312/996-7800. Check in the Office of Academic Programs, Room 138 for specific location.

Nursing students are admitted only in the Fall semester. **Transfer applicants are strongly encouraged to apply on-line at [www.uic.edu/depts/oar/undergrad/apply\\_undergrad.html](http://www.uic.edu/depts/oar/undergrad/apply_undergrad.html). It is strongly recommended that transfer applicants do not wait until the deadline to submit the on-line or paper undergraduate application. College of Nursing supplemental application materials are required and will be available after the processing of the on-line or paper undergraduate application. Information regarding the submission of the Nursing supplemental application materials is available on the College of Nursing website at [www.uic.edu/nursing/prospectivestudents/bsn-apply.shtml](http://www.uic.edu/nursing/prospectivestudents/bsn-apply.shtml).** Applicants who have a 3.25 cumulative GPA, a 2.8 natural science GPA, and who have completed at least three of the required natural science courses can apply by the early application date of **October 15<sup>th</sup>** and may receive an early admission decision by December 31<sup>st</sup>. Students who have an active RN license may apply for the RN-BSN Program through the Global Campus. **This guide is based on UIC's 2007-09 catalog and is valid for students who enroll through Fall 2009.**

## **Course Substitution Table**

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**UIC general education requirements changed beginning in Fall 2007. Transfer students who enroll at UIC through Spring 2009 will be allowed to follow either the GE pattern used prior to Fall 2007 or the new GE pattern adopted for Fall 2007. Transfer students who enroll at UIC in Fall 2009 or later will be required to follow the GE pattern adopted for Fall 2007.**

Use the following tables to estimate how UIC might accept any general education courses you may have already completed. Acceptable courses and credit hours may vary by institution. Only lower-division, introductory courses will be accepted for general education. **If a course is listed in more than one category, that course may only fulfill the requirement in one category.**
