Natural Land Management: A Property Management Strategy to Enhance Ecological value

ExxonMobil has developed a technical management practice which is designed to deliver triple bottom-line results in the management of operating properties through out their lifecycle, including their remediation and redevelopment. The practice, known as *Natural Land Management* (NLM), incorporates technical, legal and regulatory approaches to deliver value to the corporation's shareholders and the communities and environments in which we operate. The presentation will provide an overview of the NLM framework and discuss how the supporting approaches can be blended together to achieve outcomes with superior environmental performance relative to typical regulatory approaches. The integration of conservation and recreational re-use into the redevelopment of former operating properties will be highlighted. The challenges, opportunities for implementation and developmental needs will be reviewed.
