TCF Bank Scholarship
Criteria for Application/Nomination and Award
For the 2011/2012 Academic Year

Purpose

In an effort to help communities become more vibrant and healthy, TCF Bank has partnered with UIC to create the TCF Bank Scholarships. This award has been established to provide financial support to undergraduate students who demonstrate a devotion to academic excellence.

Award

Scholarships valued at \$5000 will be awarded across the two semesters of the 2011/2012 academic year (\$2500 during the fall 2011 and spring 2012 terms). The scholarship is one-year non-renewable.

Criteria

The following criteria must be applicable at time of application and maintained during the term of the scholarship:

- Must be a full- time junior or senior UIC undergraduate student.(enrolled at least 12 credit hours) throughout the award period.
- Students should show academic excellence with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better.
- Senior students must have two full semesters to complete during the award period.
- Candidates must have completed at least 60 credit hours; at least 24 of the credit hours must be at UIC.
- Candidates must have financial need as demonstrated by the FAFSA. The 2011-12 FAFSA **must** be on file in order to be considered for this award.
- Candidates must be in good academic and disciplinary standing.

Selection

The Office of the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs TCF Bank Scholarship selection committee will review applications for the above noted criteria.

Candidates will be asked to release academic records and financial aid records to the selection committee for the sole purpose of scholarship selection.

How to Apply

Applicants may submit a paper copy of the completed forms to the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs, 3010 Student Services Building. Application/Nomination forms are available in the OVCSA office or the OVCSA website at http://www.uic.edu/depts/ovcsa/see_scholarship.shtml.

The application deadline is March 11, 2011. Students will be notified no later than April 8, 2011 for scholarships to be awarded for the fall 2011 and spring 2012 semesters.
