

## Original Presentation Requirements - GWS 294

Proposal Due: April 7th

Presentation Dates: April 21, 26 & 28

Assignment:

1. **Develop a plan** for a 45-50 minute anti-violence workshop, presentation, discussion or series of activities for an informational booth. Choose a topic that relates to something we discussed during the semester. Be creative about the way you will present the information, activities, visuals, discussion starters etc. Draw on your own passions, talents and strengths and make it your own!
  
2. **Submit a typed, double-spaced Proposal** for this workshop  
Include the following (required):
  - a. Your Name
  - b. The title of your workshop
  - c. A general description of the topic
  - d. Two sources you use to develop the content of the workshop (books, journal articles, other research sources)
  - e. A list of specific goals and/or learning objectives.
  - f. The audience you feel this would be most suited for (age, group, etc)
  - g. A description of ways in which you plan to make the presentation interactive and engaging.
  
3. **Submit a typed, double spaced workshop Script** (Due at time of presentation)  
Use the "What's Love Got to Do with it?" script as a guide. Your script should include the following elements :
  - a. Your name
  - b. Workshop title
  - c. A brief (one paragraph) description of the topic
  - d. A comprehensive outline of the workshop including...
    1. all didactic information (facts, definitions, stats etc.
    2. description of activities, exercises, discussion starters etc
    3. visuals that you would use (video clips, posters, charts etc.)
  - e. Consider ways to include the concerns of oppressed, marginalized communities, lgbt, people of color, people with disabilities etc.
  - f. A reference list of all the sources you used to develop your content.
  
4. **Present in class** 10 minutes of your planned workshop (April 21, 26 and 28)
  - Select any section you want, you will be stopped at 10 minutes
  - Make sure to introduce yourself, the topic and Campus Advocacy Network
  - Bring any visuals you wish to use.
