

### ***Criterion V.F***

**The school shall offer at least one doctoral degree which is relevant to one of the five specified areas of basic public health knowledge.**

#### Expected Documentation

1. Identification of all doctoral programs offered by the school, by degree and area of specialization. The matrix in V.A may be referenced for this purpose. If the school is a new applicant and has no active doctoral program, a description of plans and a timetable for offering a doctoral program must be presented, with university documentation supporting the school's estimate.
2. Assessment of the extent to which this criterion is met.

## **Criterion V.F – Doctoral Degrees**

### **1. Identification of Doctoral Programs**

As indicated by the matrix in V.A, all four academic divisions offer doctoral programs leading to the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degree. In addition, the following divisions offer doctoral programs leading to the Doctor of Public Health (DrPH) degree: community health sciences, health policy and administration, and environmental and occupational health sciences.

Within the community health sciences division, a student may specialize in gerontology, health promotion and education, maternal and child health or enter as a generalist student.

The other divisions do not offer predefined areas of specialization.

### **2. Assessment**

This criterion is met.
