Undergraduate Grants for Scholarly Projects

Phi Kappa Phi is a national honor society for outstanding students of any academic discipline. The UIC Chapter of the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi invites academically qualified juniors and seniors to submit grant proposals for the support of their scholarly activities. The purpose of these grants is to make possible the undertaking of significant projects beyond the scope of normal coursework. A maximum of \$700 per grant will be awarded. Applicants do not have to be members of Phi Kappa Phi. Most awards are granted in support of specific research projects, though funding for attendance at a professional meeting (to present a paper) and other activities will be considered.

Interested students should obtain an application from the Honors College, 103 Burnham Hall. Applications should include the application form, a formal proposal, and a letter of recommendation from a faculty member. Applications must be submitted to the Honors College by **Thursday, April 1st, 2010**. The number of grants and the amount of the awards will be determined on the merits of the individual proposals by the Executive Committee of the UIC chapter of Phi Kappa Phi.
