## *What is the Jane Addams Festival?*

Three times a year — early in February, Memorial Day and September — the Cedarville Area Historical Society sponsors an event to bring together for a good time the people of Cedarville and the surrounding area. The September event commemorates that month's birthday of Jane Addams, Nobel Peace Prize winner and founder of Chicago's famous Hull-House, who was born in Cedarville in 1860.

This year's Jane Addams Festival on Saturday, September 24, will feature a morning 5K run and walk on the Jane Addams Trail west of Cedarville; a ceremony to mark the birthday of Miss Addams; a picnic lunch at the 1889 Cedarville School that is now a history museum, a men's-women's horseshoe tournament and events for children. The historical society will also unveil a new series of note cards depicting Cedarville as interpreted by Stephenson County artists. The highly praised premier series was introduced last year. Festival t-shirts will be available for \$10 to those not entered in the 5K run/walk or horseshoe tournament.

The board and members of the Cedarville Area Historical Society invite you to attend and participate in the festival's events and to visit this small village of 750 persons that has seen so much exciting history since the first settlers came here from the East in the early 1830s.

## *Horseshoe Tournament and Children's Events*

This year's festival will feature several events that turn back the clock — a mixed horseshoe tournament and old time games for children.

The horseshoe elimination tournament on the grounds of the Cedarville Museum will be limited to sixteen man and woman teams. Pre-registration is necessary. The fee is \$15 per person and it includes a t-shirt. A trophy will be awarded to both members of the winning team at the conclusion of the tournament. Starting time is at 8:30 a.m. There will be a 20 minute time limit for each match. Call Jim Bade, 815-563-4485 for additional information..

For children under twelve there will be four surprise events in the two age groups, **6 to 8 and 9 to 11**. First, second and third place medals will be awarded after each event. There is no cost and no need to pre-register. Just show up at 9:30 a.m. at the grounds of the Cedarville Museum. There will be supervision of these events.

## *5 K Run/Walk Course Information*

The Jane Addams Festival 5K Run and Walk will take place on the Jane Addams Trail west of Cedarville. It will start at the Wes Block Trail Head south of U.S. Rt. 20 and end at Cedarville Rd. There is off road parking at the starting point and 100 yards west of the finish. The run and walk will take place regardless of weather. **Age groups are 12 and under, 13 – 19, 20 – 29, 30 – 39, 40 – 49, 50 – 59, 60 & up and walkers.**

### *Race Day*

Late registration near the starting line is at 8:30 a.m. First age group will start at 9:30 a.m. There will be water along the route and fruit at the finish line.

### *Awards*

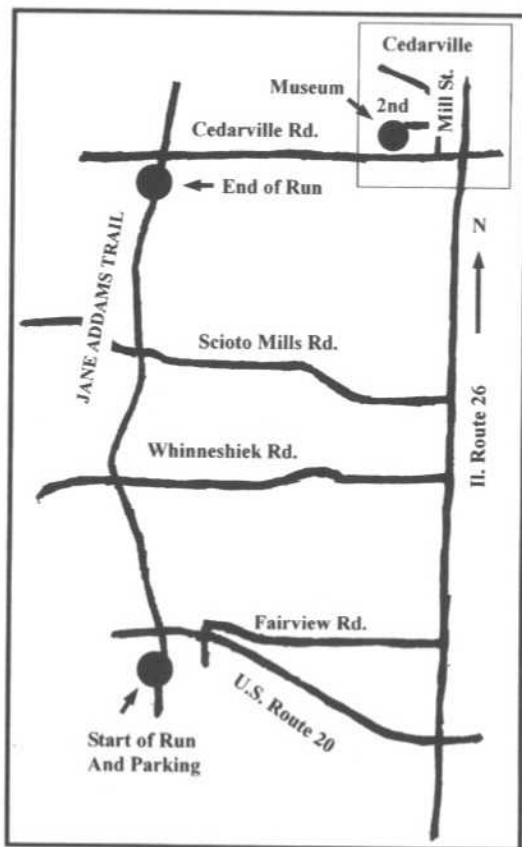
Awards will be presented at 11 a.m. at the Cedarville Museum on top of the Second Street hill just west of Mill Street. (See map) Transportation from finish line to school will be available. Trophies will go to the first overall male and female winners of the run. Medals will go to the top three finishers in the seven age groups. Everyone is invited to a picnic lunch at the school prepared by the historical society. A donation to cover the cost of the lunch will be appreciated.

## *Registration / Fees*

The fee is \$15 for those who register by Sept. 17. Those registering after Sept. 17, will pay \$18. The fee includes a t-shirt for all participants.
