

Directions from downtown Chicago to the Cedarville Area Historical Society

The trip to Cedarville is approximately 120 miles and takes around two hours. For maps from Chicago to Cedarville, or for directions from other locations, see <http://www.mapquest.com>.

- **Take I-90 (Kennedy Expressway) west from Chicago***
- **Merge onto I-39/US-51 south toward Rockford***
- **Merge onto US-20 west**
- **Exit at IL-26 toward Freeport/Monroe**
- **Take the exit ramp toward Cedarville**
- **Turn right onto IL-26 north**

***Portions of these interstates are toll roads.**

Cedarville Area Historical Society Museum: Second Street, west of Mill Street, at the top of the hill
