3. Students are required to take an additional 9 hours of credit in AAST courses selected in consultation with a departmental advisor, and distributed as follows: at least 6 hours at the 200-300 level, and at least 3 hours at the 400 level. Students wishing to substitute 400-level courses for those at the 200-300 level may do so with the permission of the department.

Note: Students must earn at least 40 hours at the 200, 300, or 400-level at a 4-year college or university. These hours may include hours in the major.

Note: Beginning fall 2007, the General Education Requirement is 9 courses, 2 laboratory courses from Analyzing the Natural World, 1 course from each of Understanding the Individual and Society, Understanding the Past, Understanding the Creative Arts , Exploring World Cultures, and Understanding U.S. Society. Two additional courses will be taken from any of these categories.

\* Two of these courses may be used to satisfy two of the nine courses in the General Education Requirement.
