1. One of these courses is recommended for this semester because the only prerequisite is Psch 100. See the first note below for the full list of choices to satisfy the requirements.
2. Excludes lab courses, which have Psch 343 as a prerequisite. Consult a departmental advisor when choosing electives.
3. Psch 343 satisfies the Quantitative Reasoning requirement. Must first satisfy math prerequisite.
4. A combined maximum of 8 hours of credit in Psch 396, 397, and 399 can be applied toward the degree.
5. At least one course must be taken from Psch 313, 321, 331, 351, 353, 361, or 363 in order to fulfill the Writing in the Discipline Requirement.

Note: At least one course from Psch 262, 350, 351, 352, 353, 360, 361, 363 and at least one course from Psch 210, 231, 270, 312, 313, 320, 321, 331 are required.

Note: Students must earn a minimum 2.40 GPA (on 4.0) in Engl 161, Math 090,118 or equiv., Psch 100, and Psch 242 with no grade lower than a C to maintain the psychology major.

Note: Students must earn at least 40 advanced hours at a 4-year college or university. These hours may include hours in the major.

Note: Beginning with the fall 2007, the General Education Requirement is 9 courses: 2 laboratory courses from Analyzing the Natural World, 1 course from each of Understanding the Individual and Society, Understanding the Past, Understanding the Creative Arts, Exploring World Cultures, and Understanding U.S. Society. Two additional courses will be taken from any of these categories.

* Two Psychology courses may be used to satisfy two of the nine courses in the new General Education Requirement. Consult the new catalog for a list of courses.
