Round II asks participants to investigate Illinois healthcare priorities: chronic disease/adult/obesity, immunizations, prenatal, outcomes, and STDs. Participants will assist in the development a one-page evidence base fact sheet per healthcare issue. These fact sheets are designed to improve the evidence-base practice of public health nurses in IL and the interventions used to promote health and prevent illness. When complete, the fact sheets will be added to the growing evidence-base repository available to public health nurses on the IPHA website.

- Subcommittee formation.
- Development of a succinct research question around the group’s healthcare issue.
- A UIC student will conduct a literature search and retrieve the latest evidence. This evidence along with your experiential advice will guide the group to report in a concise one-page fact sheet of the most current evidence to support the interventions of IL public health nursing practice.
- Activity timeframe: Group to meet approximately 6-8 times in 1 hour toll-free teleconferences. Activity to be completed no later than December 1.
