**\*\* Registration will open for advanced registration the week of November 2, 2010 and open for all students beginning November 30, 2010.** Below are important categories of registration.

- November 1 Graduate Students
- November 2 Special Groups/ Professional Students
- November 3-5 Seniors
- November 5 Juniors
- November 29 Open Registration (non-degree, re-admitted, newly admitted students and students who were not enrolled in Fall 2010.)
