

Andrew J. Donnelly, Pharm.D., M.B.A., FASHP

Dr. Donnelly received his Doctor of Pharmacy and Masters of Business Administration degrees from the University of Illinois. He is currently Director of Hospital Pharmacy Services at the University of Illinois Hospital and Clinical Professor in the Department of Pharmacy Practice at the University of Illinois at Chicago College of Pharmacy. Prior to this, Dr. Donnelly was most recently Associate Director of Pharmacy and clinical pharmacist, operating room/anesthesiology at Rush-Presbyterian-St. Luke's Medical Center in Chicago.

In his current position, Dr. Donnelly is responsible for planning, organizing, and directing the activities of the pharmacy department and ensuring the rational, safe, and cost-effective use of drugs in patients. A major focus of his at the present time is the assessment and implementation of new technology and automation to streamline and improve the medication use process. The majority of Dr. Donnelly's clinical practice has been concentrated in the areas of operating room pharmacy and anesthesiology. His areas of interest include pharmacy administration, pharmacy automation/technology and anesthesiology/operating room pharmacy.

Dr. Donnelly has published extensively in the areas of anesthesiology and operating room pharmacy. He is frequently invited to speak at professional meetings on topics related to pharmacy administration, anesthesiology and operating room pharmacy. Dr. Donnelly is also involved in the education and training of the medical, pharmacy, and nursing staffs at the University of Illinois Hospital.

Dr. Donnelly is an active member of the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP), having been named a Fellow of this organization for his work in the area of operating room/anesthesiology pharmacy practice. In addition, he is a member of the American Pharmacists Association (APhA) and Society of Critical Care Medicine (SCCM). On a state level, Dr. Donnelly has been active in the Illinois Council of Health-System Pharmacists (ICHP) for a number of years. His elected offices include President as well as Director of the Division of Educational Affairs. Dr. Donnelly received the Outstanding Division Director award from ICHP for his work with this division. In addition, Dr. Donnelly was honored by ICHP in 2002 as the Health-System Pharmacist of the Year. Dr. Donnelly has served as an elected delegate to the ASHP House of Delegates from the state of Illinois for a number of years.
