

The GRE-Prep course primarily takes place on Saturdays from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Students will also meet four Wednesdays from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm to prepare for the new essay portion of the GRE. Please note: Make-up or extra classes when necessary will hold on Wednesday afternoons. If the majority of students choose to have such classes on different dates, that option will be considered by the staff.

Parking is available in the university garage located at Paulina and Taylor.

Note: Registration fees are due on the deadline date. There is a two payment option. If you chose the two payment option, the first payment of \$150 is due at registration and the remaining \$100 on the first day of class. **Only money orders will be accepted.**

The GRE is a part of the Pre-Application/Admission Program (PAAP) of the UICSPH. It is designed to assist prospective UICSPH applicants from underrepresented communities in the health professions. Participants are prepared for the quantitative, verbal, and essay sections of the Graduate Records Examination (GRE) in a structured, yet relaxed and supportive environment. Students participate in test-taking strategies, anxiety reduction and time management techniques. Classes are limited to 20 Students.

All Classes are held at UIC School of Public Health 1603 West Taylor Street, Room 114. Registration and instruction are Free.

Students pay a Non-Refundable Fee of \$300.00 for review materials (including books and CD). Students must be registered to take the actual GRE examination before the first day of instruction (call the office if you need assistance).

To be eligible for the GRE prep courses you must:

- Be applying to the School of Public Health;
- Commit to attend at least 80% of the GRE Prep sessions (attendance will be taken during each session);
- Complete all three scheduled diagnostic tests and the post test;
- Attend the Saturday Recruitment conference corresponding to the GRE prep session being attended;
- Complete the course evaluation given on the last day of instruction;
- Be registered to take the GRE within the dates (except under extenuating circumstances) listed below the course schedule in this agreement.
