

## **Delta Omega Honorary Society**

Delta Omega is the national honorary society for graduate studies in public health. It is considered to be equivalent to Phi Beta Kappa for undergraduate studies in letters and sciences or Alpha Omega Alpha in medicine. Each year the chapter selects new student, faculty and alumni members.

Graduating students who want to be considered for this honor must be ranked in the upper 25% of their graduating class (usually this translates to a GPA of over 3.70 on a 4 point scale), and they should demonstrate qualities of leadership in public health in addition to academic excellence. Students who graduated Summer 2004 or Fall 2004, or expect to graduate in Spring 2005 are now being considered. Selection is very competitive.

If you want to be considered for this honor, please forward a letter explaining your qualifications and a CV (or resume) to Noel Chavez, President of our Lambda chapter of Delta Omega. This must be received no later than by March 15<sup>th</sup>.
