<b>Program of Study</b>	<p>The 71-76 credit program is tailored to accommodate full-time students working to complete both degrees within three academic years. Tuition and fees charged by the two programs differ. Students will be charged the tuition and fees associated with the program into which they are first accepted, usually Anthropology, and will be charged the tuition and fees associated with the other program once the semester hours of the first program have been reached. Students will be assigned joint advisors, one faculty member from Anthropology and one faculty member from the School of Public Health, in addition to the Anthropology departmental graduate advisor.
