<p>Program of Study</p>	<p>The 70 credit hour program is tailored to accommodate students on either a full-time or part-time basis. Tuition and fees charged by the two programs differ. Students will be charged the tuition and fees associated with the program into which they are first accepted, and will be charged the tuition and fees associated with the other program once the semester hours of the first program have been reached.
