

**Maternal and Child Health Track
MPH Requirements Effective Fall 2006**

MPH students entering the division of Community Health Sciences (CHS) in the fall term of 2006 are required to complete a minimum of 39 semester hour (sh) credits representing SPH and CHS core courses and additional 14-15 semester hours in maternal and child health. Some students may be permitted to waive courses if they can demonstrate having taken similar graduate level courses in the past. The final individualized curriculum including electives is planned with the assistance and approval of the student's faculty advisor. Courses are identified below including the semester in which they are *projected* to be offered.
